<sup>-</sup> it is not-for-profit;

<sup>-</sup> is a legal entity — the office of the CEO will request a copy of its statutes;

<sup>-</sup> it is membership-based and open to members worldwide or over a broad region;

<sup>-</sup> through its activities and membership demonstrates that it has the competence and expertise to contribute to the development of International Standards or the authority to promote their implementation; has a process for stakeholder engagement and consensus decision-making to develop the input it provides.
